### A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RAYMOND

Is there anything too hard for God to fix? If we believe that God is the creator of the universe, and that God created man (human kind) in His image, therefore it stands to reason that God has the ability to solve every problem, whether it is the ozone layer, climate control, wars, and our health and well being, and this all revolves around our relationship to Him. If we are to get our relationship to our fellow human beings right, we have first to get our relationship to God right. We do so by being in union with Jesus Christ.
