### A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RAYMOND

When you came to faith in Christ, what did you do? Did you wake up one morning and thought to yourself, "I believe in Jesus, I feel much better", and from then on you have said to yourself, "I believe in Jesus". This now has become your 'faith in Christ'. You continue to think, speak and act as you have done all your life. No change, no difference in character, or speech. From the outside looking in, few people would know that "I believe in Jesus". In all of our relationship to God we have to ACT, we have to respond to Him. No action, no faith in God. In coming to 'faith in Christ' you would have acknowledged that you were a sinner. An act on your part. You would have had revealed by the Holy Spirit that Jesus died willingly for your sin. The Holy Spirit would have directed you to make a prayer of faith, asking, repenting, inviting Jesus to come into your life. An 'act' of response from your part to God and then to grow in the knowledge and love of Him, to the studying of the Bible, to pray, to worship. An act from you to God. God requires us to 'ACT' upon the 'Word' (the Holy Scriptures). If we are unable to ACT upon God's Word then our faith is futile. For our faith in God to be alive, active, influential, in our lives, circumstances and situations, we have to act on the Word of God. We read that in Jerusalem Jesus healed a man blind from birth. Jesus in meeting with this man, spat on the ground, formed it into a ball of clay and anointed the blind man's eyes with it and told him to go wash in the pool of Siloam. Listen . . . There was no healing power or virtue in the spit or in the clay. There was no healing power in the water in the pool of Siloam. What happened was this. Jesus used this method, and others, to cause the man (people) to exercise their faith. These people as with this man were healed as they acted on Christ's word to them. I hope today that you begin, if you haven't already, to understand that you have to ACT ON GOD'S WORD to you. All the praying of your friends and family for your well being is wonderful, but, this in itself is not enough. You have to ACT and this is exercising your faith. No one else's. YOUR FAITH being exercised in reaching out to God for your miracle by ACTING UPON GOD'S WORD. You did it when you first came to God, you acted upon God's Word in believing that Jesus died for you, a sinner. He shed His precious blood on the cross and after being buried 3 days rose up from the grave to give to a NEW LIFE for eternity with God. You heard, you acted, you LIVE. This principle is applied to all of scripture. Whatever God says about you you can appropriate into your life by ACTING IN FAITH towards God. Every circumstance you face Jesus has already overcome on your behalf. You live in VICTORY because you believe Christ has won this battle already for you. In Jesus Name . . . AMEN.
