A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RAYMOND

What dare you believe today and act in faith? If your faith could be seen, what would it say?

As I have said before 'your faith in God' is seen by Jesus. In Matthew 9 v 27, we read - "Have mercy on us Son of David!" Let me set the scene. In Capernaum, two blind men followed Jesus. When they heard that Jesus was passing by they began to cry out. Let us be encouraged today to cry out to Jesus the Son of David. The two blind men cried out "Have mercy on us, Son of David". Jesus did not acknowledge them, for Jesus continued walking and entered into the house where He was staying. Undeterred the blind men followed Jesus into the house and came up to Him. All too often many stop just before reaching the point where their miracle is to be found. The blind men didn't give up. They didn't stop short, they kept following Jesus until they met Him. We should never give up, we should always keep pressing forward, keep pursuing until we come right up to Him. Yes we may have to overcome obstacles, we may have to push through circumstances. Doubt, unbelief, being two such forces which we have to break through. One thing we should never do is stop short nor walk away. Yes, there are times when it doesn't appear to be how we would like it but we should always recognise that it is there for a purpose. Often it is times like this when Jesus sees our faith and He then knows that we are now at the point to believe for our miracle. God is always encouraging us to press forward, not to give up. For we read that when these two blind men came right up to Jesus, Jesus asked them this question, one that He might well be asking you today. The question was this, Jesus asked them - "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" Now is your opportunity to HEAR these words of Jesus, and you ask yourself this same question. Yes, you deeply desire your miracle today. You might well depend upon the faith and prayers of others, but do you believe that what you are asking Jesus to do for you? Do you believe He is able to do this? The blind men, they made a declaration of their faith - "YES LORD". And upon Jesus HEARING their declaration of faith, Jesus reached out, touched their eyes, and said - "According to your faith be it unto you" - (Matt 9 v 27-30). IMMEDIATELY they RECEIVED their SIGHT. Today, we shouldn't get too hung up about which method needs to be used for us to receive our miracle. Today we need to be totally, spiritually, and naturally aware that

'it was according to their faith'.

Do you believe that Jesus is able to do this? Let your faith in Christ be strengthened, deepened and be seen by Him. For as Christ sees your faith your miracle is released. In Jesus Name . . . AMEN.
