## A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RAYMOND

Recognising and acknowledging who Jesus Christ is has a tremendous effect on our lives. As I have said previously Jesus sees our own personal faith which we have in Him. Jesus sees whether we believe He can do things for us or not. Jesus sees as to whether you believe He can heal you or not. Jesus sees whether you believe He can make a way forward for you or not. Jesus sees whether you believe He can provide for you or not. Everything about us in our own relationship to Him, He sees. So stop pretending, stop thinking you believe, look into your heart and come to Him. "We live by faith and not by sight". Faith in Christ – seeds miracles. In Jericho, Jesus healed blind Bartimaeus, the blind beggar. Jesus spoke the word of healing. Mark 10 v 46 – 52 . . . and as He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timeus sat by the highway side begging. And when He heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me". And many charged him that he should hold his peace, but he cried all the more a great deal, "Thou Son of David have mercy on me". And Jesus stood still and commanded him to be called. And they called the blind man, saying unto him, "Be of good comfort, rise, He calleth thee". And he casting away his garment, rose and came to Jesus. And Jesus answered and said unto him, "What wilt thou that I should do unto thee?". The blind man said unto Him, "Lord that I might receive my sight". And Jesus said unto him, "Go thy way thy faith hath made thee whole". And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus in the way.

When Jesus left Jericho, His disciples along with a great multitude of people went with Him. As you know, when you are in a crowd, there is a lot of noise and you are moved along simply by the flow of people. No time to stand still and take in the atmosphere, not time to stop and have a conversation, keep moving, and added to this, Jesus of Nazareth was there. People trying to get close to Him, people crying, shouting out to Him, some trying to get close enough to touch Him, and then as they go along the road, blind Bartimaeus sitting, begging by the roadside. You would think that he would have got swallowed up by the crowd, becoming almost invisible, but out of all the excitement of the noise, he learns that Jesus is passing by, so, by the only means to which he has to gain attention to be noticed, Bartimaeus begins to cry out in a LOUD VOICE, "Jesus Son of David have mercy on me". Bartimaeus' sole intention was to get the attention of Jesus despite everything that was going on around. He didn't, and was worried about all this. Bartimaeus sought to get Jesus' attention. What gets Jesus attention? FAITH. If you want to get Jesus' attention in your life, into your circumstances, into your health, FAITH will do it. AMEN ... in Jesus Name, GOD RESPONDS TO FAITH.
