### A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RAYMOND

One thing we all 'as believers' need to grasp, Jesus Christ has given to us the same power and authority to live in us. What a transformation this makes in our understanding and in our lives! Through the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, Christ's same power and authority dwells in us. AMEN. This power is the same, released in Christ, released in Him, to heal the sick, cast out devils, raise the dead, LIVING IN US. This maybe for some hard to receive and accept, but it is a scriptural truth. In essence it is stating that Jesus Christ's very life is being manifested within us.

Hear what Paul says - *"But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you"* - Roman 8 v 11. Therefore 'hear this', when Christ is living within us (you and I), this same power that flowed through Him and raised Him (Jesus) from the dead is in us. Listen . . . Jesus' resurrection healing power is in us not only to save our souls but the Bible says to quicken, give life, strength and healing to our bodies. I have been told that the word "quicken" translated from the Greek means . . . listen . . . 'to make alive' - 'to give life'.

The Spirit living within us, given to us after our encounter and invitation to Jesus to come into our lives, it is He who makes us alive and gives us life. At creation – Gen. 2 v 7 *"And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and He breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul"*. Jesus said - *"It is the Spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing; the words that I speak unto you, they are Spirit and they are life"* - John 6 v 63. Now can you hear that the Holy Spirit within us brings life, but more importantly, for our understanding is that this life is Resurrection Life which is given, not only to our spirits but also to our bodies which is activated as soon as we reach out in faith believing God for it.

So, likewise, the Holy Spirit brings to our soul and spirit the Life of Christ, meaning, His Holiness, His Joy, His strength, and all the spiritual blessings that Christ has promised us. So both Christ and the Holy Spirit impart to our bodies, life, strength and healing. As we receive this today it should (must) lead us to have a fresh revelation of the life of Christ and the power of His life that is imparted to our spirit, soul and body.

As we look at the resurrection healing power that flowed through Christ in the raising of the dead we will take hold of the truth that Christ has power over death. AMEN. Luke 7 v 11 - *'Jesus in Nain stopped a funeral procession and healed a woman's only son'*. In Capernaum, Jesus raised Jairus' daughter from the dead. And as you read this from Mark Chapter 5, you will find more about the people and their understanding concerning Jesus. Jairus, her father said to Jesus – v 23 - *"My little daughter is at the point of death; please come and lay your hands on her, that she may get well and live"*. As He was on His way to her a woman came up to Jesus, in fact she was so determined to speak to Him she pressed, pushed through the crowd, and in touching Jesus, Jesus turned His time and attention to her, ministering to her need. Some people from Jairus' house came up and said *"Your daughter has died, why trouble the Teacher anymore"* v 35.

Let me make this next statement very clear. These people who said that his daughter had died did not see Jesus Christ as the giver of life. They only saw Jesus as a prophet, a teacher. Hence they could not see Him for who He really is – The Giver of Life, who healed the sick. There are those who today only see Jesus as a prophet, teacher. They fail to see Him for who He really is. This is why I ask you to take a fresh look at Christ. Ask for a fresh new revelation of the life of Christ and the Power of His Life.

Jesus overheard what they said to Jairus and Jesus told him - *"Be not afraid, only believe"*. - Mark 5 v 36.

Today, these words resound in your spirit. Listen to them and act in faith upon the words that Jesus speaks to you. In Jesus Name . . . AMEN.
